THIS DEED, made this 14th day of August, in the year 1905, between the Daughters of the Confed-
eracy of the Town of Farmville, Virginia, Chapter No. 45, by Mrs. J. V. Edmunds, President and Mrs.
Laura A. Miller, Secretary, and the Prince Edward Memorial Association, by S. V. Paulett, President
and R. D. Miller, Secretary, parties of the first part, and W. T. Blanton, Mayor, H. E. Wall, W. E. Ander-
son, E. L. Erambert, W. P. Gilliam, H. E. Barrow, W. M. Duvall, S. W. Watkins, W. T. Doyme and Walker Scott,
Councilmen of the Town of Farmville Virginia, and their successors in office, Trustees, of the
second part, Witnesseth: That in consideration, that the Confederate Monument and all improve-
ments connected therewith, in front of the State Female Normal School of the Town of Farmville
Virginia, shall be kept in order and well cared for by the said Town of Farmville, the parties
of the first part do hereby grant unto the said parties of the second part, the said Confed-
erate Monument, with all improvements thereto belonging, upon the following conditions, and in
trust and for the uses hereinafter mentioned to-wit: That the title to said property shall be
in said W. T. Blanton, Mayor, and the Council as aforesaid and their successors in office, to be
held by them as a memorial to all who enlisted in the cause of the confederacy from the
County of Prince Edward, or who served in the war between the States, in behalf of the Southern
States from the said county, as well as those now living as those who may have died.
